Project update

By way of an update on the project. as many of you know Westminster City Council resolved to grant planning permission at the end of last year. We are now in the process of finalising our Section 106 agreement and continuing with detailed design work up to the start of demolition and construction work.

This is not due to start until **Autumn** 2022, in line with the expected timeframes, however you may start to see some activity around the site as surveys continue.
